Monthly Cashout Charge:

The Seller shall pay a Monthly Cashout Charge on the amount by which the aggregate Daily Delivery Quantities are greater than the aggregate Daily Transportation Quantities for the billing period ("Net Deficiency Imbalance"). A Net Deficiency Imbalance shall be considered gas purchased by the Seller from the Company. The indices used to calculate the Monthly Cashout Charge on the Net Deficiency Imbalance Quantity shall be set forth in the Sales and Transportation Operating Procedures.
