2.2.9 TERMINATION OF SERVICE-COMPANY INITIATED (Cont'd)

- G. Discontinuance of Service(s) by the Company pursuant to this Section shall not relieve the customer of any Minimum Service Period obligations or any other obligation to pay the Company for charges due and owning for facilities and/or service(s) furnished up to the time of discontinuance.
- H. The Company, by written notice to Subscriber or applicant, may immediately cancel the application for and/or discontinue service without incurring any liability for any of the following reasons:
 - 1. Non-payment of any sum due to the Company for service for more than thirty (30) days beyond the date of rendition of the bill for such service.
 - 2. Non-payment of any sum due to the Company for service for more than thirty (30) days beyond rendition of the bill on any Company account regardless of whether the application or service being canceled is related or unrelated to the account or service for which the sum is past due.
 - 3. A violation of or failure to comply with any regulation governing the furnishing of service.
 - 4. An order of a court or other government authority having jurisdiction which prohibits the Company from furnishing service.
 - 5. Failure to post the deposit required by the deposit notice as specified elsewhere in this Tariff.
 - 6. Customer places repeated harassing phone calls to the Company including calls in which the caller uses abusive language.
