### 2.3 PAYMENT FOR SERVICE

#### 2.3.2 PAYMENT OF BILLS (Cont'd)

##### B. Minute of Use Rates:

Except as otherwise specified in this Tariff, charges will be billed monthly in arrears and are due upon receipt. Subscriber will be billed for all usage accrued beginning immediately upon access to the service. Subscribers will be billed for usage occurring during their specific 30-day billing cycle, which for purposes of computing charges shall be considered a month.

Unless specified otherwise for a particular service, all calls for which a minute of use rate applies will be billed in one-minute increments. Fractional minutes are rounded up to the next minute.

If the computed charge for a call includes a fraction of a cent, the fraction is rounded up to the whole cent (e.g., \$1.244 is rounded up to \$1.25).

- C. The customer is responsible for payment of all charges for services furnished to the customer and/or authorized users. This responsibility is not changed by virtue of any use, misuse, or abuse of the customer's service or customer-provided equipment or facilities by third parties, including, without limitation, the customer's employees or the public.
- D. Billing will be payable upon receipt. Amounts not paid within thirty (30) days after the invoice is rendered will be considered past due. Interest at the rate of one and one-half percent (1.50%) per month (unless a lower rate is prescribed by law, in which event at the highest rate allowed by law) may accrue upon any unpaid amount commencing five (5) days after the date the payment is past due. When a local exchange company provides the billing function on behalf of the Company, the local exchange company's late payment fee applies.
