I. Definitions: (Cont'd)

- D. Service line: A piping, including associated metering and pressure reducing appurtenances, that transports gas below grade from a main to the first accessible fitting inside the wall of a customer's building when a meter is located within the building; if a meter is located outside the building, the service line will be deemed to terminate at the outside of the building foundation wall.

- F. Public Thoroughfare: The territorial limits of any street, avenue, road or way, other than a limited access thoroughfare, that is for any highway purpose under the jurisdiction of the legislative body of any city, town, village or county or of the State of New York and is open to public use.
- G. Cost of Basic Gas Supply: The cost to the company of its gas supply at the Canadian border price, excluding any costs related to gas purchased under peaking agreements between the company and its supplier.
- H. Residential Customer or Current Residential Customer: When used in 16 NYCRR Part 11, includes any person who pursuant to an application for service made by such person or a third party on his or her behalf, is supplied directly by the company with gas service at a premises used in whole or in part as his or her residence, as defined in 16 NYCRR 11.2(a)(2). A Low Income Customer is a Residential Customer who qualifies for the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP). A Low Income Customer Enhanced is a Residential Customer who qualifies for regular HEAP with add-ons. An add-on is provided when a HEAP recipient either has a vulnerable person, defined as an elderly or disabled individual, or child under six years, or an income level below 130% of the federal poverty level.
