Delivery Rate Adjustment

The Delivery Rate Adjustment (DRA) will apply to all customers being served under Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 5, 9, 10, 15, 16 and 17. The DRA will appear as a separate line item on the customer's bill.

The DRA will consist of a weather normalization adjustment applicable to certain heating customers (as explained on Leaf Nos. 78 and 79), a delivery rate surcharge (as explained on Leaf No. 119.50) and the Incremental State Assessment Surcharge/Credit (as explained on Leaf No. 119.51) and, where applicable, the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism (as explained on Leaf No. 119.52).

COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATION ("CCA") PROGRAM

A CCA Program allows municipalities (villages, towns and cities) to aggregate the usage of SC1A and SC 5-1A Residential Non-Heating, SC 1B and SC 5-1B Residential Heating, SC2-1 and SC 5-2-1Non-Residential Non-Heating, SC 2-2 and SC 5 2-2 Non-Residential Heating, and SC3 and SC 5-3 Multi-Dwelling Service within a defined jurisdiction in order to secure an alternative energy supply contract on a community-wide basis.

In accordance with Order issued in Case 14-M-0224, before requesting customer data from the utility for participation in a CCA Program, the municipality or their designee (CCA Administrator or ESCo) must:

- (a) sign a data security agreement with the Company, and
- (b) have an approved implementation data and protection plan and certification of local authorization approved by the NYS PSC.

Upon fulfilling the requirements listed above, the Company will provide the following information to the municipality or their designee for a charge as indicated below.

(a) Aggregated customer data, including the number of customers by service class, the aggregated peak demand (therms) by month for the past 12 months by service class if applicable, and the aggregated energy (therms) by month for the past 12 months by service class. This information will be provided to the municipality or CCA Administrator
