A. LIFELINE TELEPHONE SERVICE

1. Description

a. Lifeline Flat Rate Discounted Service - The Lifeline Program is a federally funded program established to provide monthly assistance to low income Residential Flat Rate households. Eligible subscribers will receive a monthly credit of \$9.25. Customers will also receive an additional credit to offset the residential access line rate increase made effective in Case 07-C-0349 as shown below.

b. Basic Lifeline Service - This is a metered service that provides for a \$1 monthly rate for exchange access and no monthly allowance for local calls. In addition to the \$1 monthly rate, customers will be billed \$.083 for each call made within their local calling area. These calls are untimed and billed on a per message basis. A ten percent discount applies to the first \$5 of direct-dialed local usage. In addition, this service offers a Federal Lifeline Service Credit equal to the Federal Subscriber Line Charge. This service is available only where facilities exist.
