## SECTION 6 -MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES

## A. LIFELINE TELEPHONE SERVICE

## 1. Description

a. Lifeline Flat Rate Discounted Service - The Lifeline Program is a federally funded program established to provide monthly assistance to low income Residential Flat Rate households. Eligible subscribers will receive a monthly credit of\$9.25. Customers will also receive an additional credit to offset the residentialaccess line rate increase made effective in Case 07-C-0349 as shownbelow.

b. Basic Lifeline Service - This is a metered service that provides for a \$1monthly rate for exchange access and no monthly allowance for local calls. In addition to the $\$ 1$ monthly rate, customers will be billed $\$ .083$ for each call made within their local calling area. These calls are untimed and billed on a per message basis. A ten percent discount applies to the first $\$ 5$ of direct-dialed local usage. In addition, this service offers a Federal Lifeline Service Credit equal to theFederal Subscriber Line Charge. This service is available only wherefacilitiesexist.
c. Qualified customers may choose one of the Lifeline services as describedabove. For connection of new service, service connection charges apply.Service order charges do not apply to initial changes in servicefrom:
a. Flat rate service to Basic Lifeline or Expanded Lifelineservice.
b. Basic Lifeline service to Expanded Lifeline service or viceversa.

For subsequent changes from one type of service to another, serviceconnection charges as stated in this tariff willapply.
