#### 4.3 Local Switching Optional Features (Cont'd)

##### 4.3.1 Common Switching Optional Features (Cont'd)

###### (A) Automatic Number Identification (ANI) (Cont'd)

ANI information digits are available with Feature Group D only. They include.

- (1) InterLATA restricted – Telephone number is identified line
- (2) InterLATA restricted – hotel/motel line
- (3) InterLATA restricted – coinless, hospital, inmate, etc., line

These information digits will be transmitted as agreed to by the customer and the Telephone Company

###### (B) Service Class Routing

This option provides the capability of directing originating traffic from an end office to a trunk group to a customer designated premises based on the line class of service (e.g., coin, multiparty or hotel/motel), service prefix indicator (e.g., 0-, 0+, 01+ or 011+), service access code (e.g., 800 or 900) and/or bearer capability. With the exception of Service Class Routing by bearer capability, Service Class Routing is provided in suitably equipped end office or access tandem switches and is available as a nonchargeable option with Feature Group D. Service Class Routing by bearer capability is only available in suitably equipped end offices as a nonchargeable option with Feature Group D when ordered with the SS7 Signaling Option.
