TARIFF FORMAT

- A. Leaf Numbering - Leaf numbers appear in the upper right hand corner of the leaf. Leaves are numbered sequentially. From time to time new leaves may be added to the tariff. When a new leaf is added between leaves already in effect, a decimal is added to the preceding leaf number. For example, a new leaf added between Leaves 3 and 4 would be numbered 3.1.

- B. Leaf Revision Numbers – Revision numbers also appear in the upper right hand corner of each leaf. These numbers are used to determine the most current leaf version on file with the Commission. For example, the 4th revised Leaf 14 cancels the 3rd revised Leaf 14. Because of various suspension periods, deferrals, etc. the Commission allows in their tariff approval process, the most current leaf number on file with the Commission is not always the tariff in effect.

- C. Paragraph Numbering Sequence – There are seven levels of paragraph coding. Each level of coding is subservient to its next higher level:
 - 2
 - 2.1
 - 2.1.1
 - 2.1.1.A
 - 2.1.1.A.1
 - 2.1.1.A.1.a
 - 2.1.1.A.1.a.1
