1.2 **DEFINATIONS**

Certain terms used generally throughout this tariff for the Access Services of this Company are defined below.

8XX DATA BASE ACCESS SERVICE - The term "8XX Data Base Access Service" denotes a toll-free originating Trunkside Access Service when the 8XX Service Access Code (i.e., 800, 822, 833, 844, 855,866, 877, or 888 as available) is used.

ACT - The Communications Act of 1934 (47 USC 153(R)), as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Public Law 104-104, 110 State. 56 (1996), codified throughout 47 USC and as interpreted by applicable law.

ADVANCE PAYMENT - A payment required before the start of service.

ACCESS CODE - A uniform seven digit code assigned by the Company to an individual Customer. The seven digit code has the form 950-XXXX or 101XXXX.

ACCESS SERVICES - The Company's intrastate telephone services offered pursuant to this tariff.

ANSWER SUPERVISION - The transmission of the switch trunk equipment ACCESS MINUTES - Denotes that usage of exchange facilities in intrastate service for the purpose of calculating chargeable usage. supervisory signal (off-hook or on-hook) to the Customer's point of termination as an indication. Access Service: Switched Access to the network of an Interexchange Carrier for the purpose of originating or terminating communications.

Access Service Request (ASR): The industry service order format used by Access Service Customers and access providers as agreed to by the Ordering and Billing Forum.

Access Tandem: An Exchange Carrier's switching system that provides a concentration and distribution function for originating or terminating traffic between local switching centers and Customers' premises.

Authorized User - A person, firm, corporation or other entity that either is authorized by the Customer to use Access Services or is placed in a position by the Customer, either through acts or omissions, to use Access Services.
