## SECTION 9 - ACCUNET SPECTRUM OF DIGITAL SERVICES<sup>1, 2</sup>

- 9.1 GENERAL ACCUNET Spectrum of Digital Services (ASDS) affords a Customer the opportunity to select channels at various digital speeds for end-to-end communications arrangements when connected to access. ASDS offers point-to-point connections between AT&T central offices.
- 9.1.1 Description ASDS is suitable for the transmission of digitally-encoded voice band signals or simultaneous two-way transmission of data at synchronous speeds of either 9.6 kbps, 56 or 64 kbps, or a combination of 64 kbps signals to achieve speeds of 128 kbps, 256 kbps, 384 kbps, 512 kbps or 768 kbps. ASDS connects AT&T central offices which may be within the same LATA or located in different LATAs.

The transmission specifications and performance parameters for 9.6, 56 or 64 kbps service are contained in Technical Publications - PUB 43202 and PUB 62310.

- Effective September 30, 2012, all ASDS service configurations offered in this section at speeds of 128 kbps up to and including 768 kbps (sometimes referred to as "Fractional T1 IOC") are no longer available to be ordered by new or existing Customers. Unless specified otherwise in their Customer Service Agreement, existing Customers may not add, move, change lines and/or location or renew or extend their Customer Service Agreement.
- Effective December 1, 2013, customers may not establish new term plans of any length for Intrastate Private Line Service at speeds of T45 (45 Mbps) and below, and existing term plans may not be renewed. For new service, or for existing service after any term plan expires, service will be provided only on a month-to-month basis.
