## SECTION 9 - DIGITAL DATA LOCAL CHANNEL SERVICES<sup>1</sup>

- 9.1 GENERAL A Digital Data Local Channel Service provides for the transmission of data at various speeds.
- 9.1.1 Description A Digital Data Local Channel Service provides an all digital channel for the simultaneous two-way transmission of data at synchronous speeds of 2.4 kbps, 4.8 kbps, 9.6 kbps or 56 kbps on a two-point basis.

The transmission specification standards for Digital Data Local Channel Services are contained in Technical Publications-PUB 62310 and 62507 (see Technical Publication Information, Preface).

A Digital Data Local Channel Service is furnished between a Customer's premises and an AT&T central office for connection to a DATAPHONE Digital Service or ACCUNET Spectrum of Digital Services provided under Tariff P.S.C. No. 25.

A Digital Data Local Channel Service is furnished between a Customer's premises and an AT&T central office for connection to an Analog to Digital Converter (see P.S.C. No. 25, Section 12), or two Customer premises.

In addition, a Digital Data Local Channel Service may consist solely of an access coordination function.

The Customer is responsible for providing channel service unit functionality at each local channel service termination on a Customer's premises (see Connection of Channel Service Unit Functionality, Section 9.1.2.C).

- 9.1.2 Regulations In addition to the regulations in Section 2, preceding, the following apply.
  - A. Availability of a Local Channel Service Digital Data Local Channel Services are available from the AT&T central offices in the AT&T Business Service Guide. Digital Data Local Channel Services may not be available in every LATA or to all serving wire center areas within a LATA.

<sup>1</sup> Effective December 1, 2013, customers may not establish new term plans of any length for Intrastate Private Line Service at speeds of T45 (45 Mbps) and below, and existing term plans may not be renewed. For new service, or for existing service after any term plan expires, service will be provided only on a month-to-month basis.
