SECTION 10 - DATAPHONE DIGITAL SERVICES^{1*}

(C)

- 10.1 GENERAL - A DATAPHONE Digital Service is suitable for the simultaneous two-way transmission of data at synchronous speeds of 2.4 kbps, 4.8 kbps, 9.6 kbps or 56 kbps.
- 10.1.1 Description - DATAPHONE Digital Services are configured by combining components to connect two or more AT&T central offices. AT&T central offices may be within the same LATA or may be located in different LATAs. DATAPHONE Digital Services may be two point or multipoint.
- 10.1.2 Regulations - In addition to the regulations in Section 2, preceding, the following apply.
- A. Availability of a DATAPHONE Digital Service - DATAPHONE Digital Services are available from the AT&T central offices listed in Tariff F.C.C. No. 10. DATAPHONE Digital Services may not be available in every LATA or to all wire center areas within a LATA. 2.4 kbps and 4.8 kbps services are available for existing Customers only, not available for new Customers.
- B. Credit Allowances for Interruptions - For purposes of determining credit allowances, in accordance with the regulations in 2.6 preceding, a DATAPHONE Digital Service is considered to be inoperative when:
- There has been a loss of continuity, or
 - The error performance is below the design objective of 99.5% error-free seconds, measured over a continuous 24-hour period.

* AT&T DATAPHONE Digital Services may no longer be ordered for new Customers or for additional orders received from existing Customers after November 1, 2001. AT&T DATAPHONE Digital Services in place or on order before November 1, 2001 will remain in effect until discontinued or canceled by the Customer. Customers who have the Multi Service Volume Pricing Plan (MSVPP) in place or on order before November 1, 2001 may continue to order DATAPHONE Digital Services until the expiration or discontinuance of MSVPP.

¹ Effective December 1, 2013, customers may not establish new term plans of any length for Intrastate Private Line Service at speeds of T45 (45 Mbps) and below, and existing term plans may not be renewed. For new service, or for existing service after any term plan expires, service will be provided only on a month-to-month basis. (N)
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
