2.5.11 Intrastate Access Recovery Charges

An Intrastate Access Recovery Charges as specified in the Price List, will be assessed to customers who subscribe to the following services: AT&T Commercial Long Distance, AT&T All In One, AT&T CustomNet, AT&T Small Business Option, Distributed Network, AT&T PRO WATS/Plan Q and AT&T Clear Advantage Services. This fee will be charged to all customers who incur at least \$0.01 of long distance usage or long distance charges on their monthly bill. Billed charges can be in the form of billed usage or a billed monthly fee. This fee does not apply to customers that subscribe to only AT&T Local Services.
