- 33.1.2.2.1.4 Recoveries of the Residential Commodity Related Credit and Collection Expenses per therm rate for the period April 1, 2013 - March 31, 2014 and each subsequent 12-month period ending March 31st thereafter will be reconciled to the \$2,600,935 target
