XXVII. TEMPORARY SERVICE: (Cont'd.)

- B. Gas fired emergency electric generators may be installed during periods of temporary gas usage restriction subject to the following conditions.
 - i. Only sufficient emergency electric generating capacity shall be installed to provide the minimum needs for safety and health.
 - ii. The customer shall pay all costs associated with the installation including, if necessary, all costs for system reinforcement, mains and service laterals.

XXVIII. ADJUSTMENT OF RATES IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHANGES IN THE COST OF PURCHASED GAS:

The rates for gas service under all Service Classifications shall be subject each month to the addition of a Gas Supply Charge to be applied to each unit of gas consumed by the customer.

A. Gas Supply Charge:

The Gas Supply Charge is designed to recover any difference between the base cost of gas and the actual cost of gas, subject to annual reconciliation for all service classifications.

XXIX. LIABILITY:

A. Continuity of Supply:

The Company will endeavor at all times to provide a regular and uninterrupted supply of service, but in case the supply of service shall be interrupted or irregular or defective or fail from causes beyond its control or through ordinary negligence of employees, servants or agents the Company will not be liable therefor. The Company may, without liability therefor, interrupt service to any Customer or Customers in the event of emergency threatening the integrity of its system if, in its sole judgment, such action will prevent or alleviate the emergency condition.
