## SECTION 8 - AT&T LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICES - RATES

### 8.9 AT&T ALL IN ONE

The monthly recurring charges and nonrecurring charges apply to customers who order AT&T Local Exchange Services associated with AT&T All In One within New York City, Syracuse, Buffalo, Albany, White Plains, Binghamton and Nassau/Suffolk, New York. See Price List Addendum for current rates. Monthly recurring charges, except for Term Plan customers, are accrued in full as of the first day of the billing cycle in which service is furnished. Therefore, the Monthly Recurring Charges are not subject to pro-rating if service and/or features are disconnected prior to the end of a billing cycle.
