**2.23 Emergency/ Crisis/ Disaster Restoration and Provisioning - Telecommunications Service Priority (Continued)**

**2.23.5 Preemption**

When spare facilities are not available, it may be necessary for the Company to preempt the facilities required to provision or restore a TSP service. When preemption is necessary, non-TSP services may be preempted based on the Company's best judgment. If no suitable spare or non-TSP services are available, the Company may preempt an existing TSP service to restore a TSP service with a higher restoration priority assignment. When preemption is necessary, prior consent of the service user whose service will be preempted is not required; however, the Company will make every reasonable effort to notify the preempted customer of the action to be taken.

**2.23.6 Rates and Charges**

The TSP Assignment Charge is on a per circuit or access line basis. Customers wishing to establish TSP for auxiliary numbers or circuits associated with a main billing or calling number must purchase TSP for each line assigned.

The TSP Record Order Change Charge applies to all record modifications per TSP designated line or circuit.
