- (B) A Customer who redistributes or furnishes electric energy for use of tenants or occupants pursuant to Special Provision (A) may only resell, make a specific charge for, or remeter (or submeter) or measure any of the electric energy so redistributed or furnished: (1) in accordance with Rider G; (2) if the Customer engaged in resale, remetering (or submetering) to non-residential tenants or occupants under the Wholesale Service Classification of the Company's Schedule for Electricity Service as of July 31, 1951; or (3) the electricity is provided by a publicly available electric charging station providing electric vehicle charging services to the public
- (C) Whenever a Customer's maximum demand for a period of 12 consecutive months shall not have exceeded 5 kilowatts, the Customer will thereafter be billed under SC 2.
