

9.3.1 Port Connection (continued)

A. Port Connection Configurations (continued)

Same Format/Different Format

- Optical Transport Network (OTN) to Ethernet (e.g., 10GE to OTU2)



This example illustrates a same speed/different format circuit configuration whereby there is a 10 Gbps WAN-PHY Port Connection between Customer Site A and the serving wire center and a 10 Gbps OTU2 Port Connection between Customer Site B and the serving wire center. In this circuit example, both a 10 Gbps WAN-PHY and a 10 Gbps OTU2 Port Connection charge would apply.

9.3.2 Diversity Options

Diversity options are available for the AT&T Dedicated Ethernet Service as follows:

- Port Diversity
- Alternate Wire Center Diversity
- Inter-Wire Center Diversity

Diversity options are available where facilities and/or operating conditions permit. Where facilities and/or operating conditions do not permit, special construction charges may apply as set forth in the General Regulations (Section 2) of this Tariff.
