**6.3 Application of Rates and Charges**

<b>6.3.1 Surcharges</b>	
<b>A.</b>	<b>Municipal Surcharge for Local Utility Gross Revenue Taxes</b> — In certain cities and villages a municipal surcharge to recover the additional expense related to Local Utility Gross Revenue Taxes applies as specified in P.S.C. No. 15.
<b>B.</b>	<b>Metropolitan Commuter Transportation District Tax Surcharge</b> — In the following counties, a surcharge to recover the additional expense related to the Temporary Metropolitan Transportation Business Tax Surcharge applies as specified in P.S.C. <b>6.3.2 Monthly Service</b>	
<b>A.</b>	For interexchange channels other than those within the approximate frequency range of 200–3,500 Hz, special charges will apply where amplifying or special equipment is required at the point of connection with a local channel.

\* As of October 31, 2014, Channels for Program Transmission will not be provided to new customers. Existing customers may continue to keep these services. Changes and/or moves are permitted. Renewals are not permitted.
