Statement of Tax Reform Surcredit No. 1

To PSC No. 12 Gas

Effective: January 1, 2019

This filing is made in compliance with the Order, which directed the Company to file tariff revisions to address utility rate effects of the tax law changes required by the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 (Tax Act), which was enacted on December 22, 2017. The Tax Act includes, among other things, a reduction of the corporate income tax rate from 35% to 21%.

These proposed tariff revisions are in compliance with: (i) Ordering Clause 5 of the Order, which directs the Company to file on not less than five days' notice to institute a surcredit to commence on January 1, 2019, and (ii) Ordering Clause 6, which directs the Company to include requirements for annual reconciliation filings.

Attachment 1 of this filing contains the calculation used to develop the Tax Reform Surcredit (TRS) and Attachment 2 contains the redlined tariff leaves showing the proposed revisions.

Also, in accordance with Ordering Clause 10 and as required by PSL § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720-8.1, newspaper publications of the proposed tariff amendments are currently running in affected newspapers. The Company will file proof of publication with the Commission once all publications have been made.
