Cancellation of LIC Statement No. 19

Dear Secretary Burgess,

Pursuant to the New York State Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Order Establishing Rates for Gas Service, issued and effective April 20, 2017 in Case 16-G-0257, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("Distribution" or the "Company") hereby submits Supplement No. 13 to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 9 – GAS.

In accordance with pages 76 through 78 of the aforementioned Commission Order in Case 16-G-0257, the Commission: (1) provided the Company flexibility to phase in the statewide low income program modifications by December 31, 2018, and (2) recognized that Distribution will need to end the Low Income Customer Affordability Assistance Program ("LICAAP") in order to comply with statewide low income program offerings.

Since Distribution anticipates implementing the necessary modifications on December 1, 2018 (prior to the Commission's ordered deadline), this filing cancels LIC Statement No. 19, pertaining to legacy Low Income Customer Affordability Assistance Program ("LICAAP") discounts.

Concurrent with this filing, Distribution respectfully requests a waiver from the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1, pertaining to newspaper publication, as the tariff filing is being made for transparency and clarification purposes, and because such publication requirements were previously waived for other utilities implementing the statewide low income program (i.e., ordering clause 3 of the Commission's Order Approving Implementation Plans With Modifications, issued and effective February 17, 2017, in Case 14-M-0565).
