The purpose of this filing is to further amend the Company's Service Classification No. 7 Interruptible Transportation Service ("SC 7") with regard to the New York Facilities System Surcharge or Surcredit ("NYFS"). In the initial filing that was made on October 31, 2018, the Company included SC 7 due to the fact that the class had a small allocation of peak sendout in the Company's last filed rate case. However, the Company has determined that since Service Classification No. 4 Interruptible Sales Service ("SC 4") was excluded from the allocation of the NYFS, SC 7 should also be excluded from the NYFS Surcharge / Surcredit statement going forward. The removal of SC 7 does not impact the rates that were initially filed for all other service classes.

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Attachment 1 to this letter contains the updated calculations used to develop the NYFS rates included on the statement without SC 7.

Also, in accordance with Ordering Clause 6 of this order, the requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16 NYCRR 720.8.1 concerning newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments have been waived.
