The purpose of this filing is to update The Clean Energy Fund ("CEF") and the Energy Efficiency Surcharge ("EES") for calendar year 2019. The CEF and EES factors will be set forth on the Statement of System Benefits Charge and will be included in the calculation of the total System Benefits Charge included on the customer's bill.
