**RE: Case 17-E-0741, Rider T – Commercial Demand Response Programs**

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On November 30, 2017, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to Rider T – Commercial Demand Response Programs in the Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on March 1, 2018. At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, these changes were postponed to April 1, 2018.

Staff has requested a further postponement of the tariff changes to May 1, 2018. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 59 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to May 1, 2018.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of March 23, 2018. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date.
