In compliance with Ordering Clauses No. 1, 2 and 4 of the Public Service Commission's Order Regarding Compensation of Community Distributed Generation Projects, issued and effective January 18, 2018, ("Order") in Case 15-E-0751, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files the amended tariff leaf to its Schedule for Electric Service, PSC No. 15 - Electricity.

The purpose of this filing is to address the full capacity of Tranche 3 in the Company's service territory by implementing a subsequent Tranche 4 for the placement of qualifying Community Distributed Generation (CDG) projects and to recognize the continuation of an, administratively set, Market Transition Credit (MTC) for which these projects will be compensated within the Value Stack. The leaf is to become effective on March 1, 2018 on not less than 15 days' notice.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause No. 6 of the Order, the requirements of Section 66(12) (b) of the Public Service Law and NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication of the tariff amendments described in Ordering Clause No. 1 have been waived.
