The attached Dynamic Load Management (DLM) Surcharge, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, d/b/a National Grid, is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission, State of New York:

Dynamic Load Management Surcharge (DLM) Statement No. 24

To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity

Effective: February 1, 2018

This statement is being issued in Compliance with Rule 64 – Dynamic Load Management (DLM) Surcharge of PSC No. 220 which provides for recovery of costs from customers incurred by the Company for demand response programs.

As noted on Statement No. 24, the surcharge is a credit for the calendar month of February 2018. This is the result of the Company discovering certain charges were being included in previous month's calculations and were being erroneously collected from customers. The Company upon finding this discrepancy has removed these charges in the February 2018 statement.

The Attachment 1 included with this filing supports the DLM calculation and the development of the DLM collection rate. In accordance with Rule 64.4, the DLM surcharge will be filed on not less than 3 days before its effective date.
