This filing is made in compliance with the above order issued December 14, 2017 which directed utilities to cancel the tariff leaf, and postponement supplements thereto, submitted to the Commission on August 5, 2016 proposing to implement fees for Community Choice Aggregation (“CCA”) data services requested by CCA Administrators.

In accordance with Ordering Clause 1, utilities are directed to file cancelation supplements, effective on not less than one day’s notice, on or before January 4, 2018, canceling the tariff amendments listed in Appendix 3 of this order.

Also, in accordance with Ordering Clause 3 of this order, the requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8.1 concerning newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments listed in Appendix 3 and described in Ordering Clause Nos. 1, 2 and 3 shall be waived.
