RE: Case 17-E-0639, ESCO Interval Data Charges

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On October 17, 2017, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to the Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, to eliminate interval data service charges to Energy Service Companies (“ESCOs”) and Direct Customers. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on February 1, 2018.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is postponing to March 1, 2018, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on October 17, 2017. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 56 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to March 1, 2018.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of January 26, 2018. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date.
