**Re: Case 17-E-0458, Tariff Amendments Related to Electric Energy Storage
Systems**

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On July 27, 2017, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to the Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, to enable electric energy storage systems to import from and export to the Company’s distribution system. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on December 1, 2017. At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, these changes were postponed to January 1, and then February 1, 2018.

Staff has requested a further postponement of the tariff changes to March 1, 2018. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 54 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to March 1, 2018.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of January 26, 2018. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements for the effective date change.
