## RE: Case 16-G-0061, Con Edison's Gas Rate Case

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") amendments to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the "Gas Tariff"), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The following Gas Tariff amendment is issued November 30, 2017 to become effective on December 1, 2017.

## **Reason for Filing and Tariff Changes**

The Commission in its <u>Order Approving Tariff Amendments on a Permanent Basis and</u> <u>Directing Further Modifications</u>, issued November 20, 2017, in Cases 16-E-0060, 16-G-0061 and 16-E-0196 (the "Order"), directed the Company to file tariff amendments consistent with the proposed tariff language in the Company's March 15, 2017 reply comments that were submitted in response to various parties' comments to the January 31, 2017 tariff amendments filed by the Company.

In compliance with the Order, the Company is adopting, on Leaf 183.5 of the Gas Tariff, the language proposed in its March 15, 2017 reply comments to clarify the calculation of the incremental O&M associated with the replacement of leak prone pipe above the levels established in the Rate Plan approved in Case 16-G-0061 that the Company is allowed to recover under the Safety and Reliability Surcharge Mechanism.

## **Conclusion and Notice**

The tariff revision will become effective on December 1, 2017. The Newspaper publication requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) are waived as per Ordering Clause 2 of the Order.
