Re: Case 16-E-0604: Order Providing for Eligibility of Non-Metered Accounts for Remote Net Metering

Dear Secretary Burgess:

In compliance with the Commission's Order in Case 16-E-0604 issued and effective August 2, 2017, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files the tariff leaves listed below to become effective on August 31, 2017.

The purpose of this filing is to permit non-metered accounts to be eligible as satellite accounts as part of Remote Net Metering projects and to be eligible participants in Community Distributed Generation projects, where compensation is based on Value of Distributed Generation tariffs, either as monetary crediting projects under Phase One Net Energy Metering or as projects compensated under the Value Stack. The leaves are to become effective on August 31, 2017 on not less than five days' notice.

As directed in Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Commission's August 2, 2017 Order in this Case, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) (b) and NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication have been waived.
