The purpose of this filing is of a housekeeping nature to revise the above leaf to include previously approved revisions to PSC No. 220 which were erroneously deleted from the current tariff leaf. Specifically, Seventh Revised Leaf No. 418, Section 4 - Exemptions From SC-7, Sub section (7) was approved in Case 14-E-0488 and became effective December 8, 2015. On November 17, 2016, the Commission issued Case 16-E-0497 which raised the nameplate capacity for farm service customers operating anaerobic digesters to 2MW. Eighth Revised Leaf No. 418 was filed in accordance with this Order but erroneously eliminated Section 4, Sub section (7) previously approved by the Commission.

The purpose of this filing is to revise the above leaf and reinstate sub section (7) for exemptions from SC-7 as stated above.

Because of the housekeeping/clarifying nature of this filing, waiver of the statutory requirements required under the State Administrative Procedures Act is requested for this leaf to become effective on October 21, 2017.

Also, because of the housekeeping nature of this filing, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8 is requested for this filing.
