In compliance with Ordering Clauses 7 and 8 of *Order Establishing Statewide Inspection Schedules and Procedural Requirements*, issued and effective on April 20, 2017 (“Inspection Order”) in the above referenced case, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) submits new and revised tariff leaves for its tariff, P.S.C. No. 9 – GAS as follows:

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Description

Changes to Section – Leaves 0 – 9, 0 – 14, 0 – 19, 0 – 28, 0 – 43, 0 – 50, 0 – 51 & 0 – 52 and new Section – Leaf 0 – 52.1 insert new and/or modify existing tariff language to effect the changes directed in Ordering Clauses 7 and 8 of the Inspection Order dealing with the \$100 charge, access and termination provisions.

Changes to Section – Leaves 0 – 15, 0 – 29 & 0 – 44 and new Section – Leaves 0 – 15.1 & 0 – 28.1 are non-substantive; essentially relocations of existing tariff language to accommodate the substantive changes referenced above.

Newspaper Publication

Consistent with Ordering Clause 9 of the Inspection Order, the Company will publish notice of the proposed tariff revisions in accordance with Public Service Law §66(12) and applicable regulations.
