Re: Case 15-E-0751 and Case 15-E-0082, Net Metering Transition – Phase One

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On March 27, 2017, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") made a tariff filing to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order on Net Energy Metering Transition</u>, <u>Phase One of Value of Distributed Energy Resources</u>, and <u>Related Matters</u>, issued and effective March 9, 2017, in Cases 15-E-0751 and 15-E-0082. The tariff changes were to become effective on April 1, 2017.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is postponing to April 27, 2017, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on March 27, 2017. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 47 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to April 27, 2017.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days' notice and has an effective date of April 30, 2017. However, since the pending tariff leaves currently have an effective date of April 1, 2017, the Company requests that it be authorized to put the Supplement postponing the effective date to April 27, 2017, into effect on short notice, <u>i.e.</u>, April 1, 2017. The Company also respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date.
