RE: Case 16-S-0715, Changes to General Information 3 of the Steam Tariff

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Steam Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – Steam, applicable to its steam customers in the Borough of Manhattan, New York City.

The revised tariff leaves, which are identified below, have an effective date of May 1, 2017:

Reason for Filing

The Commission’s Order Approving Tariff Amendments (the “Order”), issued and effective April 20, 2017, in Case 16-S-0715 approved, with one modification, the Company’s filing made December 21, 2016 (“December 2016 Filing”). The December 2016 Filing proposed changes to General Rule 3.1.5, “Prepayment for Extension or Reinforcement of Mains,” and General Rule 3.2.2, “Prepayment for Installation of Service Line and Furnishing of Service Equipment,” and the associated Rider A and Rider B agreements, effective April 1, 2017. Because the effective date of the December 2016 Filing was subsequently postponed to May 1, 2017,¹ the Order directed the Company to file tariff amendments to revise the effective date of the rule changes to May 1, 2017.

¹ The postponement was approved by S.P.O. 16-S-0715SP issued and effective February 10, 2017.

Tariff Changes

Pursuant to the Order, the Company has modified General Rule 3.1.5 and General Rule 3.2.2 to indicate that the changes are effective for applications made on or after May 1, 2017.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the tariff amendments are filed, on not less than one day's notice, to become effective on May 1, 2017. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
