On October 26, 2015, in Matter No.15-02220, the Department of Public Service ("Department") approved Magna5 LLC's¹ ("Magna5") Petition for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to operate as a reseller of telephone service with authority to provide local exchange service. At that time, Magna5 stated that it initially planned to provide only non-basic retail services, and accordingly, it filed a copy of its Customer Service Guide that listed the rates, terms and conditions of its non-basic retail services. This filing serves to inform the Department that Magna5 now intends to offer basic retail services. This filing contains Magna5's proposed Local Exchange P.S.C. No. 2 Tariff. Magna5 respectfully requests that this tariff become effective on September 6, 2018.
