On June 8, 2018, certain utility, industry, and developers of the Interconnection Policy Working Group (IPWG) and Interconnection Technical Working Group (ITWG) filed a Petition for Clarification of the April 19, 2018 Order Modifying Standardized Interconnection Requirements (SIR) and accompanying Exhibit A. The IPWG/ITWG Commenters requested that the Commission clarify specific elements of the SIR contained in Exhibit A, implement certain non-material edits, and advise of an effective date of the modified SIR.

The purpose of this filing is to incorporate the modifications reflected in the SIR set forth in Exhibit A of the Commission's Order Granting Clarification issued and effective July 13, 2018 in Case 18-E-0018 into the Company's tariff and also update the SIR as an addendum. The leaves and addendum are to become effective on July 19, 2018 on not less than one day's notice.

As directed in Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Commission's July 13, 2018 Order in this Case, the requirements of Public Service Law 66(12) (b) and NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication have been waived.
