This filing is being made in compliance with Ordering Clause 1 of the above order which directed the electric utilities to file, on not less than ten days’ notice to become effective June 1, 2018, tariff revisions necessary to reflect the waivers as discussed in the body of this order, for Community Distributed Generation (“CDG”) projects serving only farm operations and residences of individuals who own or are employed by the served farm operations. Attachment 1 included with this filing indicates where the changes have occurred.

Also per Ordering Clause No. 3 of the above order, the requirements of Public Serviced Law Section 66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1 related to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments are waived.
