The purpose of this filing is to revise Rule 40 –Value of Distributed Energy Resources (VDER) as it relates to the Environmental Value calculation methodology adopted in the VDER Phase One Order. The attachment included with this filing contains a redlined leaf showing where the changes have occurred.

The Company’s Value of Distributed Energy Resources “VDER” Value Stack Credit Statement has been updated to use \$0.02741 per kWh as the Environmental Value for eligible projects that pay 25% of their interconnection costs, or execute a Standard Interconnection Contract if no such payment is required, on or after March 9, 2018.

Also, in accordance with above Order, the revisions in the above case are to become effective on not less than 5 days’ notice.
