Pursuant to the Commission's regulations, (16 NYCRR) Section 720, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a/ National Grid NY ("the Company") hereby files the following statement which will take effect on **March 7, 2018** for gas transactions conducted from **February 1 through February 28, 2018:**

Statement of Seller Charges and Adjustments No. 105 which sets forth the Swing Service Demand Charges, Daily Balancing Service Demand Charge, Unitized Fixed Cost Credits, Daily Cash Out Prices and Penalties, Monthly Cash Out Price, Mandatory Capacity Program Prices, Commodity Related Credit and Collection Expenses and the Unaccounted for Gas percentage applicable to customers taking service under Service Classification No. 19 and Electric Generators taking service under Service Classification Nos. 18-5A and 20 of PSC No. 12-GAS.

In accordance with the "Order Adopting Recommendations of the Power Generation Collaborative Phase One Report and Approving Related Tariff Amendments", issued January 19, 2018 in Case 16-G-0059, the Daily Balancing Service Demand Charge applicable to Electric Generator Non-Core Transportation has been updated to reflect the revised calculation approved in the proceeding.
