Dear Secretary Phillips:

The following tariff amendment, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”), is being transmitted in compliance with the April 16, 2021 *Order Approving Transfer of Property Interests* issued by the New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”) in the above case number (“Order”):

Tenth Revised Leaf No. 229
To P.S.C. No. 220 – Electricity
Effective: May 1, 2021

On October 6, 2020, the Company filed a petition (“Petition”) requesting authorization under Public Service Law Section 70 to transfer certain assets to Union Falls Hydropower Limited Partnership for \$1,500,000.

Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Order directed the Company to file tariff amendments to modify language to allow credit of certain costs, on not less than five days’ notice and to become effective May 1, 2021. Per Ordering Clause No. 4 of the Order, requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) (b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication of the tariff revisions are waived. Attachment 1 contains the Company’s redlined tariff leaves showing where the changes have occurred.
