Purpose of Filing

The Companies are filing amendments to its tariffs in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Order to effectuate the cost recovery of NYSERDA's Program Sponsor funding costs billed to the Companies through the existing Bill-As-You-Go agreement.

Overview

The Companies are filing tariff revisions to implement a surcharge to recover the charges billed to the Companies for NYSERDA's Program Sponsor expenses. The Companies will recover program costs through an Integrated Energy Data Resource ("IEDR") Surcharge that will apply to customers that take electric delivery service from the Companies. The surcharge will be on a per kWh basis for non-demand customers and on a per kW basis for demand-billed customers.

The IEDR Surcharge will be included in the System Benefits Charge on customer bills. An annual statement setting forth the IEDR Surcharge shall be filed with the Public Service Commission on not less than 15-days' notice to become effective January 1st.

Newspaper Publication

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 11 of the Order, newspaper publication in accordance with Public Service Law 66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR 720-8.1 is waived.
