Re: Case 19-E-0079 Order Continuing Certain Exemptions to Standby Rates

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In compliance with the Commission's Order Continuing Certain Exemptions to Standby Rates, issued and effective May 14, 2021, in the above captioned proceeding, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company"), hereby files the amended tariff leaf listed below to become effective June 1, 2021 on not less than 10 days' notice.

8<sup>th</sup> Revised Leaf No. 272.10

The purpose of this filing is to 1) extend existing exemptions to standby rates for residential customers, small commercial non-demand customers, and designated technologies for a period of two years until May 31, 2023, and 2) eliminate standby rate exemptions for Combined Heat and Power systems put in service after May 31, 2021.

Pursuant to ordering clause 6 of the Order, a waiver of the requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication was granted.
