These tariff leaves are issued March 29, 2021, to become effective April 1, 2021.

This filing is made in compliance with the Commission's Order Approving Tariff Amendments on a Permanent Basis, issued and effective March 19, 2021, in the above referenced proceeding (the "Order").

Pursuant to the Order, the Company is making a filing to incorporate tariff revisions that became effective on February 1, 2021, in Case 20-E-0376,¹ with tariff revisions implementing Rate Year 3 delivery rates that became effective on a temporary basis on January 1, 2021, and were subsequently approved on a permanent basis in the Order. The Electric Tariff leaves being filed today incorporate the language from both filings.
