Dear Secretary Phillips:

The Brooklyn Union Gas Company, d/b/a National Grid NY (“the Company”) hereby submits its Statement of Temperature Control Interruptible Revenue Reconciliation Surcharge/Credit No. 4 (“Statement”) in compliance with Rule 52 of PSC No. 12 Gas Tariff. The Company has performed a reconciliation of its Temperature Control and Interruptible revenues for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Effective March 1, 2021 through February 28, 2022, the following Temperature Control Interruptible Revenue Reconciliation Surcharge/Credit will be implemented:

- Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BI, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2-1, 2-2, 3, 4A, 4A-CNG, 4B, 7, 17 and 21: \$.0053 per therm.
