## **Re: Customer Information System Modernization**

Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or the "Company") hereby submits the proposed tariff amendments listed below to become effective July 1, 2021.

The purpose of this filing is to modify existing tariff language pursuant to the changes that will take place when the Company upgrades our current Legacy Customer Information System (CIS) in July 2021. Some of the changes that are included in these tariff amendments include:

- The Energy Cost Adjustment Mechanism factor for Service Classification No. 5 will now be prorated based on the number of days each Energy Cost Adjustment Mechanism Factor is in effect during a customer's billing period.
- Revenue Tax factors for both gas and electric will now be shown as multipliers rather than divisors.
- Retail Suppliers that provides either electric and gas supply along with an area light will be charged one-half of the electric or gas consolidated billing charge.
- Deferred Payment Agreement for both electric and gas have been updated to incorporate changes that will take place with the CIS modernization.

As the Company considers these amendments will have no direct impact to customers, the Company requests that the requirements of §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication for the amendments listed herein be waived.
