RE: Case 21-E-0140 - Tariff Filing by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. to Make Housekeeping Changes to Become Effective March 5, 2021

Dear Secretary Phillips:

On February 3, 2021, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”), proposing changes to its Schedule for Electricity, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, to incorporate text that was previously approved. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on March 5, 2021.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is postponing to May 1, 2021, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on February 3, 2021. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 72 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to May 1, 2021.

This Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of April 1, 2021. However, since the tariff leaves currently have an effective date of March 5, 2021, the Company requests that it be authorized to put the Supplement filed today into effect on short notice, i.e., March 5, 2021. The Company also respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements for the effective date change.
