Attachment 1 details the rates calculated for each service classification by VDER Value Stack component. Also included in the calculation is the 2020 reconciliation of all costs paid to VDER Value Stack projects between December 1, 2019 and November 30, 2020. This calculation is detailed in Attachment 2. Attachment 3 is the workpapers with the detailed cost allocation and rate design for each VDER Value Stack component. Please note that Attachment 3, page 5 details the environmental market calculation using NYSERDA's alternative compliance payment (ACP) price, less 10% administrative adder, as a proxy until the quarterly auction clears.

This VDER Value Stack Cost Recovery Statement is filed with the Commission on not less than three (3) business days before the effective date in accordance with Rule No. 40.2-Value Stack in PSC No. 220 Electricity. VDER Value Stack Cost Recovery Statement No. 41 is effective March 1, 2021 for batch billed customers and March 1, 2021 for calendar month billed customers.
